### LIGHT DESIGN as VISUAL ART

#### Rosemount Steeple Center

Artistic Lighting Installation on the steeple of the former St Joseph's Catholic Church, now owned by the City, at the heart of a major new senior housing development. 18 color-mixing exterior and interior LED light fixtures, computer-controlled DMX programming. Commission awarded by the City of Rosemount in 2015; project budget \$123,000.

#### Luminous Landmark 2017

Temporary public-art lighting installation on south façade of Landmark Center at Rice Park, St Paul, during Winter Carnival 2017. 32 moving lights controlled through theatrical lighting desk. Ever-shifting light play created full-building color washes, highlighted architectural details and sent dynamic winter-themed imagery playing across the facade. Project budget \$54,000; lead funding as one of 42 recipients of Knight Foundation's inaugural Arts Challenge in St Paul, 2014.

#### Currents

Commissioned by FORECAST Public Artworks.

Permanent installation at entry tower of Amherst H. Wilder Foundation office building, St. Paul MN. Colormixing LED fixtures programmed through ColorPlay software; HID ellipsoidal fixtures with fixed and rotating patterns. Rear-projected on 12'x16' frosted glass windows. Project budget \$30,000.

#### An Evening of Light Entertainment

A full evening of lighting art in theatrical performance format. Lighting was the primary visual performance element; designed unique scenic environments for each of four pieces of new music and performed lighting specific to each.

#### Lightlines

Funded in part by FORECAST Public Artworks

Temporary installation running six hours nightly for one month on then-abandoned Shubert Theater (now Cowles Center) in Minneapolis. Theatrical lighting instruments in weather-resistant enclosures and exterior architectural fixtures, running cue sequences programmed through theatrical lighting console, shone through building's fire escapes and on artist-installed plexiglas mirror panels which swung in the wind. Project budget \$10,000.
